

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

Some of their names can still be read on crumbling tombstones erected thousands of miles from the places where they were born. And there, back home, the tale of their emigration has taken on the shimmer of legend.



Helen also played Hodel in *Fiddler on the Roof* and Fantine in *Les Misérables*, starred in the Swedish production of *Chess* and as Polly Peachum in *The Threepenny Opera*, and is currently playing Eliza in *My Fair Lady* in Stockholm. Helen has performed solo concerts on radio, television, and on stages around the

country and is a lead vocalist in the Benny Andersson Band.

RUSSELL WATSON



Russell Watson (*Karl Oskar*)'s music career changed forever in 1999, when he sang the world cup anthem, "Nessun Dorma" before Manchester United's Premiership winning game and was signed by Decca Music Group. A factory worker from Salford, he went from performing in pubs to selling over six million albums globally and was dubbed The People's Tenor. Russell was the first British male to simultaneously occupy the number one spot in U.K. and American classical charts and to have the number one album in the U.K. classical charts for an entire year. With multi-platinum albums and four Classic BRIT Awards, Russell is

recognized world-wide as the U.K.'s biggest selling classical artist of the 21st century.

Member of the Royal Swedish Academy of Music, honorary doctor of the College of Humanities at Stockholm University. Married to Mona Nörklis, father of three children, grandfather of five.

BJÖRN ULVÆUS

Björn Ulvaeus (*Creator/Original and English Lyrics*). Born in 1945 in Gothenburg on West Coast of Sweden. After a successful career in Sweden with a folk group in the mid '60s, he began collaborating with Benny Andersson and formed ABBA with Agnetha Fältskog and Anni-Frid Lyngstad. Even during the ABBA years, the idea of writing a musical seemed appealing, and in 1981 Björn and Benny met Tim Rice and co-wrote *Chess* with him, which opened in the West End in 1986. In 1995 *Kristina Från Duvensta* opened in Sweden, which played for three years. He went on to co-produce *Mamma Mia!* with Judy Craymer, which opened in London in 1999.

HERBERT KREITZMER

Herbert Kretzmer (*English lyrics*) is a South African-born, London-based newspaperman (Critic of the Year, 1980) and lyricist whose credits include *Les Misérables* (Tony and Grammy Awards 1987-88). His many lyrics written for French singer Charles Aznavour include "Yesterday When I Was Young" and the chart-topping

LARS RUDOLFSSON

Lars Rudolfsson (*Director*), born in 1951, is one of the most respected and sought after directors in Sweden. His breakthrough was his 1985 production of *Pygmalion* at the Orion Theatre in Stockholm. He directed Benny Andersson's and Björn Ulvaeus' musical *Kristina*, which premiered in Malmö in 1995, and is considered one of Sweden's national musical treasures. Rudolfsson has directed a wide range of classical and modern plays, musicals, and operas. His recent work in the U.S. is Bizet's *Carmen* at the Santa Fe Opera. He has received many awards, among them the Litteris et Artibus medal for Outstanding Artistic Achievements as Director and Producer."

ROBIN WAGNER

Robin Wagner (*Set Design*), Broadway designs include revival of *A Chorus Line*; *The Producers* (Tony Award); *The Boy from Oz*; *Kiss Me, Kate*; *Saturday Night Fever*; *Side Show*; *Angels in America*; *Victor/Victoria*; *Jelly's Last Jam*; *City of Angels* (Tony Award); *Crazy for You*; *Jerome Robbins' Broadway*; *Chess*; *42nd Street*; *Dreamgirls*; *On the Twentieth Century* (Tony Award); *A Chorus Line*; *Jesus Christ Superstar*; *Leony*; *Promises, Promises*; *The Great White Hope*; and *Hair*.
